I directed this portfolio for three years and due to circumstances beyond my control resigned before being able to complete my term of office.

Having worked with board colleagues and a great support team, during my time on the portfolio we changed NISA test judging to relate to IJS. Also at this time we supported all the clubs to move away from RJS.

The new challenge will be to create a development programme to attract new judges, reinstate the proposed Technical Panel annual training and exams and support the results/data group in further development, building on the excellent foundations they have been putting in place over the last four years.

Importantly I believe this portfolio can spear head judge/technical on-line training to help new officials as well keep established officials up to date without making as many demands on their time.

This portfolio covers wide and varied groups of officials, many of whom have great experience and knowledge in their fields. It is therefore important to work as a team and if elected I would again invite people into key roles as I believe this will offer a sound support base to all concerned and has proven both successful and popular previously.

I strongly believe in good continuity where sound policy is in place and do not believe in change for change sake. However, where change is needed to deliver the portfolio in support of judges and officials I will always find a way to champion necessary change in their support as required
