



LEVEL 2-5 PERFORMANCE COACH CRITERIA- SYNCHRO

LEVEL 2

For full accreditation as a Level 2 NISA Coach, the individual must have been the coach of a team that has competed twice at the British Synchro Championships in the Novice, Junior or Senior categories.

LEVEL 3

This would require full ISU International events on 2 separate occasions in the Novice, Junior or Senior Categories and having achieved the NISA Performance Scores for the particular category and having a team at an ISU Championship (Junior or Senior) or Junior World Challenge Cup.

LEVEL 4

This would require having teams in the JWCC / ISU Junior or Senior World Championships on two separate occasions and achieving a position of 12th or better.

LEVEL 5

This would require having teams in the JWCC / ISU Junior or Senior World Championships on three separate occasions and achieving a top 10 placing.

There should be no reference to team members changing or the same team having to be the ones competing. This would all be subject to final ratification by the NISA Synchro Advisory group (or whichever group you felt was appropriate).
