



LEVEL 2 COACH CRITERIA

Prerequisite

- Registration and fee (£263 *prices valid from January 2015 – January 2016*)
- Current NISA Membership
- Minimum age 17 yrs old to apply, must be 18 yrs old on completion of course
- Minimum level 6 NISA Test pass in Field Moves and one part Level 6 in Singles or Dance (*Short Track trainees arranged separately*)
- Level 1 assistant Coach License must be held previously for a minimum of 6 months on completion of course.
- 2 years from the time of application to complete the course (*after 2 years your application will become void, if you then wish to carry on you must re-apply*)

Module 1

- Completion of NISA policies and Procedures
- Safe Guarding and Protecting Children Workshop – scUK (Sports Coach UK)
- First Aid
- CRB check
- Public Liability acquired on completion of all other requirements

Module 2

- Sports Coach UK Workshops

Module 3

- Sport Specific Knowledge and understanding of elements and how to teach them

Module 4

Mentor Training – A chosen mentor may now be a level 2 qualified coach however this is **ONLY** permitted as long as the Coach has attended the mentor session at the Coaches Convention 2012 and has been an independently qualified coach for 3 years or more. All other mentors must be a minimum of level 3 coaching qualification.
